Vehicle – SVS or Property - APS

Basic Rule: If it has wheels or tracks and you sit and steer the equipment it is a vehicle - *enter as stolen in SVS*. Vehicle Definition 415 / 670 VC – Key is Self-Propelled or Towable

Second Rule: If it has wheels and tracks and you walk behind it to steer it and or not self-propelled or towable, it is probably property– *enter as stolen in APS*.

Exceptions: Construction Equipment attachments are property that can be entered into SVS as vehicle parts. **Serialized buckets can only be entered as a vehicle part.**

All LoJack equipped equipment: Enter as a VEHICLE



Vehicles: SVS – Stolen Vehicle System Entry Only (CHP 180 or equivalent)

Property: APS – Automated Property Entry Only (Agency Incident Report)
